Crucified and Risen

Scripture Theme Song: “This is a faithful saying” (1 Timothy 1:15,17; 1 Corinthians 15:10)

- 1) The prophecy of Jesus about sufferings and death
 - a) Luke 9:44-45 (see also Matt. 17:22-23)
 - i) Why were the disciples unable to comprehend that Jesus had said to them?
 - b) Luke 17:24-25
 - c) Luke 24:7 – reminder from the angels
 - d) Luke 24:25 – reminder from Jesus
- 2) The struggle in Gethsemane
 - a) Luke 22:39-44
 - b) Notice that this was the place where Jesus usually came to pray. What lesson can we learn for our lives today?
 - c) Why was the experience of Jesus in Gethsemane such an intense struggle?
 - d) We can also pray “Not my will but Yours be done” but how can we be sure what God’s will is?
 - e) Luke 22:1-6
 - f) Luke 22:20-22 – why didn’t Jesus publicly expose Judas? (see also John 12:4-8)
- g) We are all tempted by Satan. How was Satan able to enter Judas?
- h) How can we avoid the same mistake of leaving the door open for Satan to enter? (Revelation 3:20)
- 3) Taking a stand for or against Jesus
 - a) Sanhedrin – Luke 22:66-71
 - i) John 7:50-52 – not every member rejected Jesus
 - ii) John 19:38-40 – Joseph and Nicodemus
 - b) Pilate
 - i) Luke 23:1-7
 - ii) Luke 23:13-17
 - iii) Matt. 27:19
 - iv) Luke 23:18-25
 - v) What lessons can we learn from Pilate wavering attitude instead of taking a stand for Jesus?
 - c) Herod Antipas
 - i) Luke 23:6-12
 - ii) Why does Jesus refuse to speak to Herod?
 - d) The two thieves
 - i) Luke 23:39 (see also Mark 15:27-32)
 - ii) Luke 23:40-42 – what caused the change in the one thief’s attitude toward Jesus? (Luke 23:34)
 - iii) How did Jesus respond to this thief? Luke 23:43
- 4) He is Risen
 - a) Luke 24:1-12 – the tomb is empty
 - b) Luke 24:13-49 – post-resurrection appearances
 - c) 1 Corinthians 15:1-6 – inspired testimony of Paul
 - d) Acts 17:30-31 – confirmation by God the Father
 - e) How does the certainty of Christ’s resurrection give you hope today?
