- 1) The reign of King Josiah – 640-609 BC
 - a) 16th king to rule the southern kingdom
 - b) How old was Josiah when he became king? 2 Kings 22:1
 - c) Does 2 Kings 22:1 surprise you in the light of the fact that Josiah’s father Amon and grandfather Manasseh were two of the most evil kings of Judah?
 - d) What important discovery was made early in the reign of king Josiah? 2 Kings 22:3-11
 - e) What two important reforms did king Josiah implement? 2 Chronicles 34:30-33
 - f) 2 Kings 23:25 How would your life be summarized?
- 2) The reign of King Jehoahaz (Shallum) -3 months
 - a) 2 Kings 23:31-34
 - b) Jeremiah 22:11-17
 - c) What is your reaction to this brief account?
- 3) The reign of King Jehoiakim – 11 years 609-598 BC
 - a) 2 Kings 22:34
 - b) 2 Kings 22:35-37 – what terrible mistake did King Jehoiakim make?
 - c) Jeremiah 22:1-19
 - d) What Bible characters were teenagers during the reign of Jehoahaz and Jehoiakim? How is it possible to remain pure and undefiled in the midst of such wickedness? Daniel 1:8
- 4) The reign of Jehoiachin – 3 months
 - a) 2 Kings 24:8-16
 - b) What message did the LORD send to those who were taken captive, including King Jehoiachin? Jeremiah 29:11-14
 - c) We all face challenges of various kinds. Why is it important to remember that our future and hope is found in the faithfulness of God?
- 5) The reign of Zedekiah (Mattaniah) – 8 years
 - a) 2 Kings 24:17-19
 - b) 2 Chronicles 36:14
 - c) 2 Kings 25:1-7
 - d) What lessons can we learn king Zedekiah’s story?
 - e) Bad things happen even to good people. What difference does it make whether we trust in God or not? (remember Jeremiah 29:11)
- 6) A message to the remnant
 - a) Why did Nebuchadnezzar show favor to the prophet Jeremiah? Jer. 39:11-14
 - b) What promise was given to the remnant? Jer. 23:2-8
 - c) How does that same promise encourage us today?
- 7) Discussion question: What is the relevance of these ancient stories for our lives today? 1 Cor. 10:11
