- c) 1 Peter 2:21–25. How did Jesus redeem us through the shedding of His “precious blood”? (see Isaiah 53:1–12; Romans 5:8)
- d) How does an awareness of what Jesus has done for your redemption impact your life today?

**3. Jesus, our Risen Savior**

- a) 1 Peter 1:3–4, 20–21 (see Acts 2:22–24,32; Acts 4:33)
- b) What hope does the resurrection of Jesus give those who believe in Him? (see 1 Corinthians 15:12–20; Revelation 1:18)

**4. Jesus, our Messiah**

- a) 1 Peter 1:1–3. What is the significance of adding Christ to the name of Jesus? (15x in 1st & 2nd Peter)
- b) Peter's confession, Matthew 16:13–17
- c) What kind of Messiah were the Jewish people of Christ's day expecting? (John 7:40–43)

- d) How did Peter's understanding of Messiah's mission change? Luke 24:44–48

**5. Jesus, our Lord**

- a) When Peter reacted to the miraculous catch of fish, why did he call Jesus Lord? Luke 5:4–8.
- b) 1 Peter 1:3
- c) 2 Peter 1:2, 10–11, 16 (see also Philippians 2:5–11)
- d) What is the significance of Stephen's prayer at the time of his death? Acts 7:59–60
- e) How does our personal relationship with Jesus as our Savior and Lord enable us to face death unafraid?

**6. Discussion questions**

- a) If people were to examine our testimony to the world, would they come to the conclusion that “it's all about Jesus”?
- b) How can we make Jesus the center of our lives?
- c) What does the apostle Paul mean when he says “Christ lives in me”? Galatians 2:20
